



POST-SYMPOSIUM TOUR

There are two periods of the symposium. The first period (Aug. 25-27) will be held in Hefei City, and the next two day will move to Mt. Jiuhua.

Hefei City, the capital of Anhui Province, has a history of more than 2,000 years, which is well known both at home and abroad as "a historic site famous from the Three Kingdoms Period and the hometown of Lord Bao". There are many places for sightseeing. The most famous three are Mingjiao Temple, Xiaoyaojin and Lord Bao's Memorial Temple.

Jiuhua Mountain is a sacred place of Buddhism. It is located in south of Hefei City. The Buddhism was established in 719 AD by Kim Qiaoque, a prince of XinLuo (today is called as Qingzhou City in South Korea), who came to Mt. Jiuhua for 75-year cultivation of Buddhism and died at 99 years of age. His corporeal body is stayed intact and now is displayed in the temple to the visitors. Because he had a similar appearance to Dizang Buddhisattva, the monks there believed Dizang Boddhisattva was reincarnated in him and took the place to hold rites for Dizang Boddhisatva. Now Mt. Jiuhua is also a famous scenic spot of China.

SUBMISSION OF ABSTRACTS
